## SHOW REGULATIONS

Riding hats must be worn at all times when mounted.

No entry fees will be refunded if the competitor withdraws.

Messingham Horse & Foal Show Committee (MHFSC) reserves the right to vary the order & composition of this Schedule and to decline any entry without being required to give a reason. Class times may vary from those scheduled.

In the event of there being insufficient starters lower prizes may be withheld.

Unaffiliated Show Jumping objections must be made to the Secretary within 15 minutes of completion of the class in writing and accompanied by a cash deposit of £30:00. This deposit will be forfeited if the objection is overruled.

BSJ Rule 198. Objections must be made to the Secretary within 30 minutes of completion of the class in writing and accompanied by a cash deposit of £100:00. This deposit will be forfeited if the objection is overruled.

All persons participating in the show in any way do so at their own risk. MHFSC will not accept any legal liability whatsoever for any loss or damage to property, including the transmission of any infectious disease to any animal. MHFSC will not accept legal liability for injuries to any person, except for death or personal injury arising from the negligence of MHFSC, its servants or agents.

MHFSC has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of all participants. All persons on the showground are expected to do the same and to comply with all instructions of Organisers, Officials and Stewards

The showground is laid out so that competitors and members of the public are kept apart. All persons attending the show must keep within designated areas.

No person(s) shall allow a stallion for which they are responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any class / competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other competitors, show officials or members of the public are not put at risk of injury.

By entry competitors agree to be photographed.

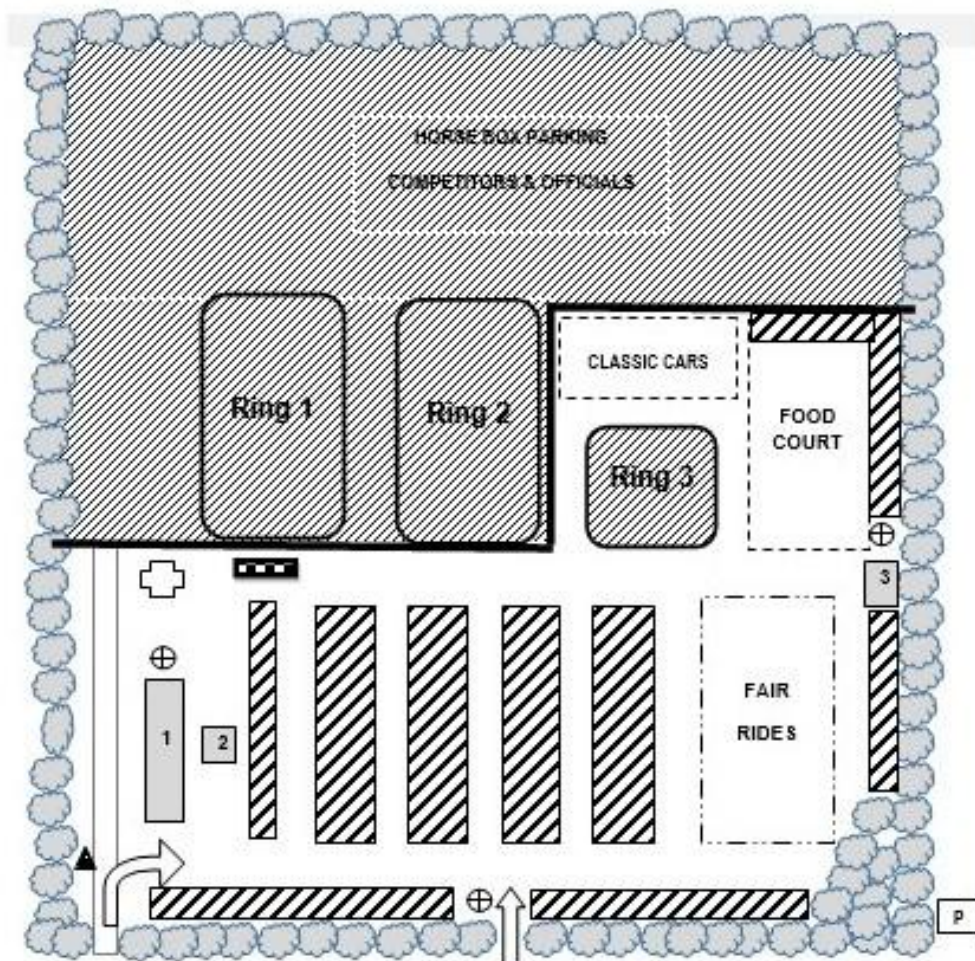

The onus is on every competitor / rider who suffers a fall, or anyone who suffers an injury whilst on the showground, to report the fall / injury to the on-site Paramedics AND Show Secretary.

**All riders / competitors are required to make a contribution of £2.00 to help pay for the Paramedic cover provided on the day.**

**CLASS 1 - 09:00 – RING 1**

**KBIS Insurance Senior British Novice Championship First Round /  
90cm Open**

Rule 316. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by KBIS Insurance Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6.

British Novice: For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 125 points ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. Qualifies for: KBIS Insurance British Novice Championship - Second Round. Qualifying period yearly 1st May - 30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four KBIS Insurance British Novice First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in and attend four KBIS Insurance British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular KBIS Insurance British Novice competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

90cm Open: For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

The two sections will be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.”

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

b) For all horses that are five years or under at the year that the final is going to be held, irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6. Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four First Round competitions held in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in and attend four Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6.

**Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £18.00, 4th: £18.00, 5th: £17.00.**

**Entry Fee = £15.00.**

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Connolly's RED MILLS In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6.

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6

(b) For all registered horses that are six years or under at the year that the final is going to be held, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior Newcomers Final - in accordance with rule 312.6 Four double clears to qualify. Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Second Rounds. Qualifies for: Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers Second Round. Qualifying period 1st June - 31st May inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers First Round competitions in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in a Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). To obtain a double clear qualification, even if the horse is the only clear round, it must jump a jump-off round and jump clear to gain a double clear round. The winner of a particular Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

**Prizes: 1st: £40.00, 2nd: £30.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £15.00, 5th: £15.00.**

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

**Prizes: 1st: £40.00, 2nd: £30.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £15.00, 5th: £15.00. Entry Fee = £15.00.**

### **Class 6 - approx. 15:00 - RING 1**

#### **Senior Foxhunter – First Round /1.20M Open**

Rule 310. Table A7. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.20m.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Foxhunter section:

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6

(b) For all registered horses that are seven years or under at the year that the final is going to be held, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify. Four Double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st June-31st May inclusive. Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2017 are not eligible for qualification to the 2018 Championship.

Open section:

For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

**Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £20.00.**

**Entry Fee = £16.00**



**Class 7 - approx. 16:45 - RING 1**

13.2hh and 14.2hh handicap. 13.2hh fence height 70cm and 14.2hh fence height 80cm.

**Class B6 PRE-NOVICE**

exceeding 14.2hh (combination not having won £30.00 this year). Fence height 60cm.

**Class B7 NOVICE HORSE**

exceeding 14.2hh (combination not having won £30.00 this year). Fence height 70cm.

**Class B8 INTERMEDIATE HORSE**

exceeding 14.2hh. Fence height 80cm.

**Class B9 OPEN HORSE / PONY.**

Fence height 90cm.

### Riding Hats

A 'riding hat', designed to provide protection, must be worn, at all times when mounted by anyone, whether or not a Competitor. Harnesses must be properly adjusted and fastened at all times when mounted.

When competing, including warming up, all competitors must wear 'Protective Headwear' i.e. a hat, which meets one of the following standards:

- **British – All PAS 015, VG1** Provided they are BSI kite-marked
- **European – VG1** Provided they are BSI kite-marked
- **American – All SEI ASTM F1163 04a onwards and SNELL E2001**
- **Australian & New Zealand – AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards**

Competitors are strongly recommended to check their hats regularly and to replace them if damaged, or following a fall.

Messingham Horse & Foal Show shall not suffer any liability (whether for death or personal injury or for any consequential or indirect loss suffered) in relation to protective helmets worn by riders and in particular but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing any failure by riders to wear protective helmets to the above standards.

The onus is on every competitor / rider who suffers a fall, or anyone who suffers an injury whilst on the showground, to report the fall / injury to the on-site Paramedics AND Show Secretary.

The showground is laid out so that competitors and members of the public are kept apart. All persons attending the show are asked to keep within these designated areas and NOT to cross any safety barrier or tape.

All competitors are reminded / advised that the show ground also comprises of attractions for members of the public that involve moving parts, lights and sound. Consequently young, inexperienced or timid horses will require extra supervision on show day.

In the interests of safety if you are in any doubt please do not enter your horse or pony in the show.
